Scope:

Sustainability Governance:

The Board of Directors assumes a pivotal role in establishing the organization's sustainability strategy and goals, whereas the Management Team assumes the responsibility of incorporating sustainability considerations into the strategic planning processes and executing the established sustainability strategy by converting it into practical initiatives and projects.

Principles:

We are guided by the following principles:

- 1.0 RTB Group commits to align with the United Nation's Sustainable Development Goals (UN SDG) which is the blueprint to achieve a better and more sustainable future for all.
- 2.0 RTB Group commits to align with the Paris Climate Agreement. The Paris Agreement sets a long-term goal of substantially reduce global greenhouse gas emissions to limit the global temperature increase in this century to 2 degrees Celsius while pursuing efforts to limit the increase even further to 1.5 degrees.
- 3.0 Our respect for the rights of our workforce and those within the communities where we operate is embedded throughout our corporate policies, practices and expectations which reflects our commitment towards United Nations Universal Declaration of Human Rights and International Labor Organization Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work (ILO Declaration), including:
 - Freedom of association and effective recognition of the right to collective bargaining.
 - Elimination of all forms of forced or compulsory labour.
 - Effective abolition of child labour.
 - Elimination of discrimination in respect of employment and occupation.
 - Provide a safe and healthy working environment.

Other policies that support RTB Group's values and commitment to human rights include whistleblower policy, sexual harassment and grievance handling procedures.
